DISCIPLESHIP PROCESS AGREEMENT

As a team, we are submitted to Tabernacle leadership for pastoral ministry, accountability, and discipleship purposes. Living as a disciple of Christ we dig deep into the Word, the Spirit, relationships, and community, in order to grow into and become all the Lord has for us. This means that if there is an issue or challenge that arises, we address things directly in a biblical way with the person(s) involved, always with the goal of restoration. The leadership reserves the right to ask individuals to take a break from platform ministry if necessary to assess a situation and address any discipleship issues.

MODESTY AGREEMENT

Our goal is to bring attention to God, His glory, His goodness, and the fullness of who He is, therefore we are sensitive to dress and act in ways that do not distract those we are leading. All team members commit to avoid tight-fitting, revealing, or excessively sloppy clothing. For ladies, tops should not have low necklines and "safety" shirts should be worn as necessary, if wearing a skirt it should fall below the knee. Men, shirts, and pants should not be overly tight. For regular Sunday worship services only, please avoid hats, loud prints, and plaids, and ripped or aged jeans. A simple color scheme is established and posted on Planning Center for Sunday morning and special services; backup colors are black and neutrals.

COMMITMENT TO EXCELLENCE

Vocalists: your voice is an instrument, so take good care of it. Warm up at home, or in the car, on your way to church, and drink plenty of water before and after services.

Instrumentalists: your instrument is a tool of worship not only of performance. Simplicity is key. We must never musically step on each other, or clutter the worship experience with too much improvisation. Communicate with each other and constantly follow the lead-worshiper and/or chief musician present.

We are never finished learning and growing as individuals and a team.. All team members commit to continued learning, private and group practices, attending team days, and utilizing resources that leadership makes available.

Diligence in learning and digesting the music before Sundays are expected. Worship will only flow freely when the music has previously become a part of who we are ...
